

CERTIFICATE OF DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

Effective July 1, 1987, The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (Parts 383, 391 and 392) contain certain requirements that you as a driver of commercial motor vehicle must follow.

1. To may not possess more than one driver's license.
2. According to 392.42 and 383.33 of the FMCSR, you must notify your company the next business day of any revocation or suspension of your driver's license.
3. Part 383.31 requires that you must report to my employer and the State that issued your license any time you violate a state or local traffic law (other than Parking) in any6 vehicle within 30 days. This notification must be in writing and contain the following information:
 - a. Driver's full name
 - b. Driver's license number
 - c. Date of conviction
 - d. Nature of violation (other than parking)
 - e. Indicate whether the violation was in a commercial motor vehicle as defined in Part 383 of FMCSR.
 - f. Location of offense
 - g. Driver's signature
